International Roaming Charges

Roaming charges vary depending on your network and the country you are visiting. Most destinations are covered by simple daily passes, which allow you to use your UK allowance abroad (subject to limits).

Below is a clear breakdown by network, including the countries covered in each zone.

EE Roaming Charges

How It Works

When you use your phone in one of the countries listed below, a daily roaming charge is applied. This gives you access to your UK allowance while you are abroad (subject to limits). A charge is triggered when you start using data, calls or texts (1MB trigger applies).
